

### **Our Next Project – School Solar Panels**

We were recently in discussions with Roger regarding the purchase of a gel battery versus a lithium battery in conjunction with solar panels. The lithium battery costs more but has a much longer life than the gel battery. We decided that the purchase of a lithium battery would be a wiser choice for longevity.



#### **Energy Storage**:

Solar panels produce electricity when exposed to sunlight. However, this energy production is intermittent and dependent on weather conditions. A battery allows you to store excess solar energy generated during the day for use when the sun isn't shining, such as during the night or on cloudy days.

#### Smooth Power Supply:

Batteries help smooth out the power supply by providing a consistent and stable flow of electricity. They can assist in maintaining a steady power output even when solar energy production fluctuates due to passing clouds or other temporary shading.
